Saturday Clinic: AM Dressage, PM Show Jumping and Cross Country

Dressage lessons groups of 4. Group jumping lessons.

Fran will discuss current eventing dressage tests BN-T levels and help riders work through problem areas. After lunch will be stadium and cross-country jumping including banks and ditches over rolling terrain.

Sunday Test: AM Judged Dressage Tests and Event Derby

Ride a test (BN-T event tests), confer with Fran, and re-ride. Ride up to 2 levels. Complete the weekend by making it a derby: jump a combination of stadium and cross-country jumps over rolling terrain. Design your own course. Multiple rides allowed.
